

Costs to consider for Driver CPC Training

Your Own Training Example (over 5 year period)

X10 Drivers = 350 Hours Training Costs (all plus VAT)

Using Training Providers

X10 Drivers = 350 Hours Training Costs (all plus VAT)

Based on cost of £125.00 per driver per 7 hour course. **£ 6,250.00**

What if I have more than 10 Drivers?

Your Own Training - Additional Driver Cost	£43.70
Outside Provider - Additional Driver Cost	£625.00

What if I have fewer than 10 Drivers?

Reduce figure by

Your own Training	£43.70	per driver
Outside Provider	£625.00	per driver

Conclusion:

If you have 10 or more drivers and the means (manpower & room) to deliver the training yourself, you would be saving money, especially if you sell the training to other companies.

Selling periodic training to others could cover the set-up costs if you become a training provider, by selling to 10 drivers over the 5-year period, therefore the training would not cost you anything.

If you have a number of drivers with no training means, then by the figures provided, you should consider regular training by training providers spaced out to lessen the financial impact.

If you have around 10 drivers you could group train them using training providers all on one day, which should bring the cost down to around £1,000.00 a year.

We all understand that when a driver is not at work you are not earning and extra costs are incurred.
